## A CHASHIVUS FOR TORAH

*Dear Editor,*

Rabbi Yaakov Applegrad re-  
cently wrote an opinion and a sug-  
gestion regarding the Lakewood  
*chavrusah tumult* that takes place  
on the first day of the new *zeman*.

In my opinion, the suggestion  
was offered by someone with proper  
qualifications in these matters. Rabbi  
Applegrad has been the Executive  
Director of *Yeshiva and Mesivta  
Torah Temimah* for over 30 years  
and well understands the importance  
of the first day of a new *zeman* and  
the value of learning Torah.

I will relate an incident that took  
place on January 17, 1994 in which  
I was personally involved. On that  
day, New York was hit by a crazy  
rain/ice/hail storm that turned the  
streets into sheets of ice in a matter  
of moments, making both driving  
and walking treacherous. I was near  
the *yeshiva* and decided to pick up  
my then 4-year-old son. I entered  
the office and saw Rabbi Applegrad  
huddling with other members of the  
*hanhalah* and the school bus driv-  
ers discussing the weather situation.

Rabbi Applegrad questioned  
me as to the driving conditions,  
traffic, time to drive to the *ye-  
shiva*, etc. He asked my opinion  
about dismissing classes early. I  
suggested that based on the  
weather, there should be early dis-  
missal. Rabbi Applegrad re-  
sponded, "One hour of learning  
for 800 *bochurim*? Do we have  
the right to be *mevatel* 800 hours  
of Torah learning?"

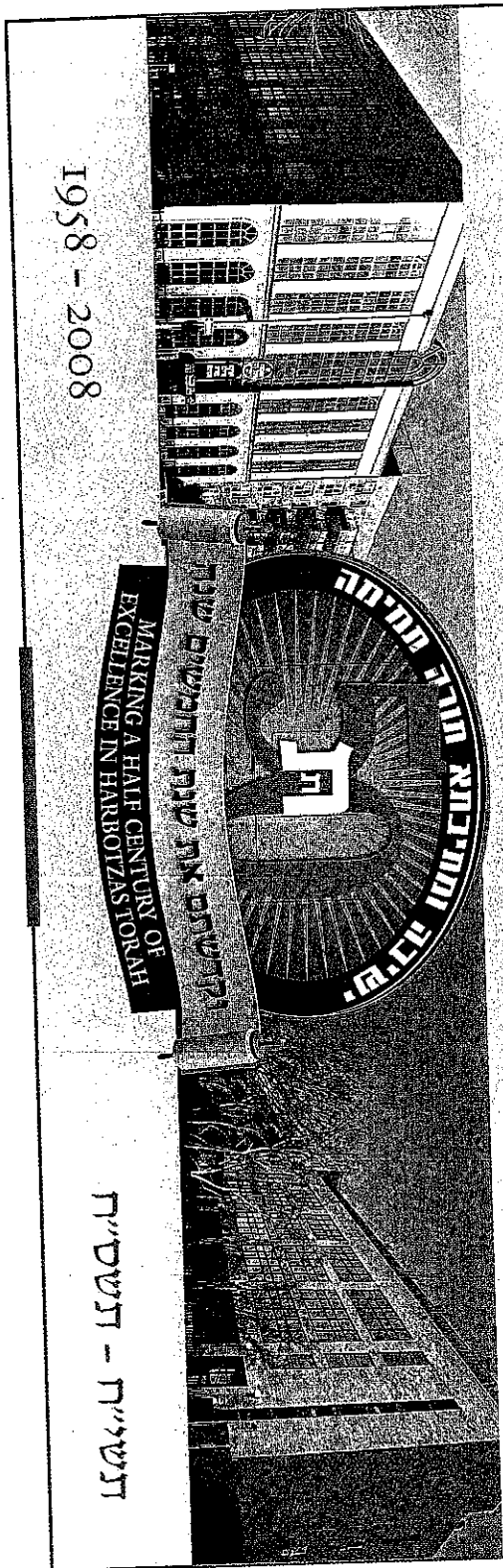
